How can a parent of a Maywood Middle School student demonstrate our school-wide expectations?

RESPONSIBILITY

- Call the school attendance office to report an absence.
- Know your child’s teachers and friends.
- Keep up with your child’s assignments and homework.
- Notify the school of any changes in behavior.
- Pick up your child after dances and sporting events in a timely manner.
- Communicate your concerns to the administrators, counselors, or teachers.
- Make sure your child has good attendance and arrives on time.
- Enforce the school dress code.
- Remind your child of school-wide expectations.

INTEGRITY

- Encourage your child to make good choices at school.
 - Honor good behavior and grades.
 - Communicate the importance of education.
 - Provide a time and place for your child to do homework.
 - Demonstrate the importance of reading.
 - Spend time volunteering at school.
 - Communicate, Communicate, Communicate!
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SAFETY

- Inform the nurse of any medication changes or illnesses.
- Drop off and pick up students in an area free from moving cars and buses.
- Keep a child with a temperature above 100° to rest at home.
- Give the school your emergency phone numbers and update information.
- Know your child's after-school / transportation plans.
- Know your child's friends.
- Make sure your child is bringing appropriate items to school.



COURTESY

- Use polite language and tone on the school premises.
- Try to schedule your child's appointments and vacations during school breaks.
- Use appropriate communication channels to address a problem.
- Schedule appointments to meet with teachers during non-instructional times.
- Let the faculty and staff know you support and appreciate them.
- Show good sportsmanship at sports activities.
